## How treeShield® works

- Your arborist will inspect the large trees that are in the Managed Area of your property as defined in the treeShield® Limited Warranty.
- Your arborist's inspection report will be submitted to Horticultural Asset Management, Inc. (HMI) for review and approval under treeShield®.
- Upon approval you will receive a welcome letter from HMI and a complimentary HMI treeFacts® Report. This report documents the type, size, location, general health and replacement cost of the trees inspected by your arborist.
- In the event your property is not approved, your arborist will contact you to discuss the actions required to qualify your property.
- Once treeShield® takes effect please contact your arborist to report a warranty claim.
